IAVI is pleased to announce a social media fellowship as part of the TB Vaccine Advocacy Roadmap (TB Vax ARM) efforts, set to launch in January 2022. The fellowship will convene **three TB vaccine R&D advocates** representing TB affected communities and early career researchers for a **social media skill building and campaign development program**.

Starting during the **last week of January**, the fellowship will engage advocates in a **15 hour program** over the course of **six weeks**, ending in the first week of March. In collaboration with the IAVI communications team, the fellows will develop and run a social media-based TB vaccine R&D advocacy campaign in the lead up to the **6th Global Forum on TB Vaccines**, taking place between 22-24 February 2022. This initiative will provide a global platform for the fellows to develop their social media advocacy skills while contributing to an advocate-led call to action to TB vaccine R&D stakeholders ahead of the Forum.
